2. What does John 11:25-26a say?
3. When we are resurrected, we will be like Jesus after His resurrection. Describe at least two of the qualities of a resurrected body as per the descriptions of Jesus. (Clues: Luke 24:36-40,42-43; 1 Corinthians 15:49.)
4. Is the typical picture of a saint floating on a cloud strumming his harp an accurate picture of activity in Heaven? If not, why not?
5. What or who is the “cloud of witnesses” in Hebrews 12:1?
6. Do all prophecies come directly from the Lord or are some delivered by His servants? Give a verse to support your answer.
7. Who brought John a revelation of the future in Revelation chapter 19?—An angel, or someone who had once lived on earth? (Clue: Revelation 19:9-10)
8. If you were speaking with someone who was afraid of death, what verse could you give to comfort them?
9. Explain something that you feel you should be doing to prepare for Heaven.
10. How is the life cycle of butterflies an illustration of death and resurrection?
