  10. Imagine you've witnessed to someone and they're now ready to pray to receive the Lord. Write out a salvation prayer that they could repeat after you.
  11. If someone is too shy to pray, or reluctant, what can you do?
  12. What's the solution if you find yourself too shy to witness? (Clue: Acts 1:8)
