5. Where is the first place to look for guidance to help us deal with our problems? (Clue: Psalm 119:105)
6. Who is the “accuser of the brethren”? (Clue: Revelation 12:10)
7. If we resist the Devil, what will he do? (Clue: James 4:7)
8. Is it a good thing to ask other people for counsel and prayer? (Clue: Proverbs 27:9b)
9. Does it matter *who* we seek counsel from? (Clue: Romans 15:1a)
10. Why is it important to confess when you've done something wrong? (Both to the Lord and in some cases asking the forgiveness of others.) (Clue: Proverbs 28:13, James 5:16)
11. Philippians 4:8 contains a list of things we should meditate on. What are these things?
12. When finding solutions to and overcoming our problems, what is the primary means of outside help we should employ? (Clue: Psalm 50:15; Psalm 32:8)
